

I move that this precinct caucus support the following Resolution:

1. Guarantee the right to life of every preborn human being in the State,
2. Provide equal protection of the laws to every preborn human being in the State,
3. Immediately abolish the murder of preborn human beings by abortion in the State, and
4. Maintain an abortion-free State;

A Resolution explaining that public policy permitting abortion is in violation of the God-given, inherent right to life described in the Declaration of Independence and preserved by the Constitution of the United States; explaining that the supreme Court of the United States has violated the Constitution of the United States; calling on the republican party to seek to immediately abolish abortion.

WHEREAS, all human beings are created in the image of God, and are thus endowed by their Creator with an unalienable right to life; and

WHEREAS, governments are instituted by God among mankind, being charged with the duty to secure and protect the right to life, and establish justice for all; and

WHEREAS, abortion constitutes murder, depriving an innocent human being of life; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the United States is the supreme law of the land throughout all the States and Territories of our union; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the United States mandates that no State shall deprive any human being of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law, nor deny to any human being within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the laws; and

WHEREAS, Article 1 Section 7 of the Minnesota Constitution states: “No person shall be.. deprived of life, liberty or property, without due process of law;”

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute 609.185 defines Murder in the First Degree: “Whoever..(1) causes the death of a human being with premeditation and with intent to effect the death of the person or of another;”

WHEREAS, every executive officer and judge in this State has sworn: “I do solemnly swear or affirm that I will support the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of Minnesota, and that I will discharge faithfully the duties of the office...in the County of...in the State of Minnesota, to the best of my judgment and ability, and

WHEREAS, by allowing the murder of innocent preborn human beings by abortion to go unabated and unpunished, particular Minnesota Counties, and the whole government of the State of Minnesota, have abandoned their most basic moral duties and legal obligations; and

WHEREAS, by falsely claiming the “right” to murder one’s child by abortion is a right protected by the Constitution of the United States, the supreme Court of the United States has willfully and egregiously perverted the meaning of the Constitution; and

WHEREAS, any statute, court opinion, or executive order purporting to legalize the murder of a class of human beings clearly and egregiously violates the Constitution of the United States and the MN Constitution and the higher Divine Law of God; and

WHEREAS, public officials in Minnesota are bound by solemn oath and moral duty to provide the equal protection of the laws to all human beings in Minnesota and comply with the Constitution of the United States; and

WHEREAS, The Platform of The Minnesota Republican Party 2018 states: “1. Republicans believe that every innocent human being, born and unborn, has an inalienable right to life from conception to natural death.

NOW THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** BY THE MINNESOTA REPUBLICAN PARTY

THAT we insist that every public official in the state, elected and appointed, including but not limited to County Sheriffs, city police chiefs, peace officers, district attorneys, and judges, exercise their authority as appropriate in their respective jurisdictions to:

1. Guarantee the right to life of every preborn human being in the State,
2. Provide equal protection of the laws to every preborn human being in the State,
3. Immediately abolish the murder of preborn human beings by abortion in the State, and
4. Maintain an abortion-free State; and

THAT we call upon the state legislature to enact legislation which immediately abolishes abortion;

THAT every public official in the state, elected and appointed, including but not limited to County Sheriffs, city police chiefs, peace officers, district attorneys, and judges, ignore and refuse to enforce any and all federal statutes, regulations, executive orders, and court opinions that would deprive an unborn child of the right to life and of the right to equal protection under the law.
